However, many researchers struggle with designing robust experiments, executing them systematically, analyzing results properly, and packaging their findings for publication in reputable journals. This workshop provides a practical, step-by-step framework to help researchers transform ideas into publishable studies. It is suitable for early-career researchers, postgraduate students, and clinicians engaged in scientific research.
